

New Diploma in Agriculture, Zambia Institute of Agriculture

The Zambia Institute of Agriculture (ZIA), in partnership with the Cambridge Centre for Environment (CCE), is this year starting a diploma course in agriculture, commencing 14th August 2017 in Ndola. The course offers the following subjects.

1. Crop science;
2. Farm Management;
3. Farm Machinery/ Engineering;
4. Livestock Production;
5. Aquaculture;
6. Agricultural Economics;
7. Land Management, Environmental Conservation & Management;
8. Nutrition, Food Security and Sustainable Agriculture.

The course will involve 8 sessions, and will be completed by April 2020.

The ZIA was founded by Chris Kapembwe, a TAA member, who heads our Zambia & Southern Africa Branch. The CCE was set up by Martin Kaonga, a TAA member living in Cambridge.

They are now seeking interested experts to help. Any TAA member is invited to pick a session subject, in which they feel qualified to teach, and contact Chris. If the offer is accepted, ZIA will arrange and pay for flights and cover the costs of stays and other logistics. A session takes one week.
